BEDWYN/GRAFTON LINK SCHEME FORTHCOMING CHANGES



Our Coordinator, Brenda Nolson, will retire in February 2014, partly due to regulations of the Charity Commission. Brenda has served as "the voice of the Link Scheme" for a decade almost entirely on her own, with occasional holiday cover. Until recently she provided a seven day a week service taking and making calls through the day. No amount of "thank-yous" can be adequate for this selfless service to the community.

Brenda's replacement will not be an individual but a team of volunteers, simply because no single person can be found who is willing to do what Brenda has been doing all these years. Each volunteer coordinator will be available at the same telephone number (**01672 870120**) every weekday between 9am-2pm. This means that clients will not notice any change except missing Brenda's familiar voice. I shall be writing to all regular clients and volunteers to explain the changes.

Through the months of December 2013 and January 2014, coordinator training is in progress. It is envisaged that a mobile phone and laptop will be transferred each day between coordinators. Exact details are being worked out with the help of Community First. Emma Glenister, a member of the Management Committee, will be the Lead Co-coordinator. The new system will hold activity data on a laptop as well as a booking log which will record volunteer activity and client usage. The system is in use by other Link Schemes in the county.

Further announcements will be made as arrangements are finalised.

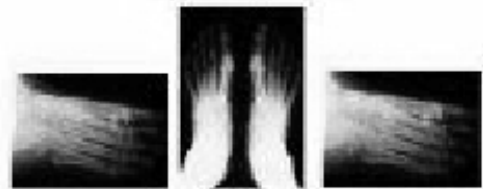
